We will endeavor to promote a sense of self-worth, self-discipline, and self-confidence as well as an awareness of the rights and feelings of others. We are optimistic that this approach to education will develop the necessary skills to be happy and productive participants at Shaker Ridge and in society.

Behavior	Expectations	Range of Consequences
Respect for Authority	-Respect and follow the requests of instructors, Pro Shop personnel, lifeguards, general manager, and staff. -No swearing	Junior members will be removed from the situation
Respect for Others	-Be courteous to all -Show tolerance for ethnic, racial, religious, sexual, & ability differences -No play-fighting, bullying, or fighting -No throwing sand, ice, or other objects -Junior Members should set an example for their peers.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Privileges may be withdrawn • An apology may be appropriate • Parents may be involved • Restitution (time and/or money) is expected for vandalism and other damage. This may be in the form of Club Service • Each child will be issued a maximum of 3 warnings and then the guardians, General Manager, Youth Camp Coordinator and Youth Camp Chair will be asked to meet and discuss the reoccurring problems.
Respect for Property	-Respect the property of others (no stealing or vandalism) -Place all garbage in appropriate containers -Stay away from the cars in the parking lot -Fire alarms and safety equipment are there for our protection, do not abuse them. -Locker room supplies are for the use of all members. Do not abuse or waste them.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Suspension • Expulsion <p>Discrimination is considered to be extremely serious and can lead to a longer suspension. The Club policy is for "Zero Tolerance" of play fighting, fighting and/or bullying. Each will generally result in a suspension.</p>
Dangerous/Restricted Items	-Any item that is used with the intent or threat to injure is not allowed on club property (for example, water guns, plastic guns, cap guns, caps, sling shots, knives, matches, etc.)	
Instruction	-Junior members should come prepared for the day's activities (sports equipment, apparel) -Junior members must attend a full day of camp and participate in ALL ACTIVITIES unless they need to leave for doctor's appointments etc. It is the guardian's responsibility to speak with the head counselor and notify him/her prior to the child leaving. -Complete all tasks to the best of their ability, with pride -Avoid disruption of class	- Junior members will be removed from the instruction - Privileges to participate may be withdrawn

Golf Course Conduct	A junior member must behave at all times in a manner becoming of a gentle person and of a Shaker Ridge Country Club member. Unbecoming conduct includes cheating, showing disrespect to other members, volunteers or officials, abusive language, club throwing, profanity, littering or leaving trash on the course, failing to rake bunkers, replace divots, repair ball marks on greens, or other displays of inappropriate behavior.	Any conduct unbecoming a junior golfer shall be subject to one warning by the Professional Staff and immediate loss of golfing privileges for subsequent occurrences.
Swimming Pool Conduct	-No running -No diving -No pushing or other unsafe behaviors -No littering or leaving trash in the pool area	Junior members will be removed from the situation - Privileges may be withdrawn - An apology may be appropriate -Parents may be involved
Dress Code	-Juniors must wear a collared shirt, Bermuda shorts or slacks and shoes and socks. -T-shirts, tank tops, short shorts and blue jeans will not be acceptable.	Juniors not conforming to the dress code will be asked to change or leave. Remember that the use of metal spikes is prohibited.
Substance Abuse	Cigarettes, alcohol or prohibited drugs are not allowed	-parents to be involved -items taken away - suspension -police to be involved for prohibited weapons and drugs
COVID-19 Regulations	Comply with all regulations set fourth by the program director and counselors regarding COVID-19 regulations. Campers must wear a mask unless otherwise advised and maintain social distancing whenever possible.	Campers may be asked to wear a mask/stay six feet away. Campers may be asked to leave the camp if there is continued non-compliance.
